

STATEMENT OF UNION:

In response to the war in Ukraine, we, an association of art institutions, communities, and individuals from Aarhus, will commit to providing various resources and infrastructures for dissidents and refugees with a visual arts background (in a broad sense of the term). We take on this responsibility jointly and individually. We will welcome all visual artists who have had to leave their homes in recent years out of necessity. We will continuously update a catalog of activities, materials, networks, residencies, etc., which is offered to dissidents and refugees who wish to preserve their artistic identity, be a part of professional communities, and have an artistic sanctuary.

Additionally, we will work to ensure that artistic experiences and creative opportunities can be offered to all refugees in Aarhus Municipality, including children.

Furthermore, we will reach out to the other arts and work to establish interdisciplinary initiatives in Aarhus Municipality.
